


EPA AIR EMISSIONS RULES FOR BOILERS

Timeline for Major Source and Area Source Rules



*A major source is a facility that emits or has the potential to emit 10 tons per year of a single hazardous air pollutant (HAP) or 25 tons per year of total HAP. An area source is any facility that is not a major source.
**EPA's No Action Assurance (NAA) establishes that the agency will not take action against facilities that fail to meet the stated criteria by the compliance date published in the Federal Register.
